## PRIORITY TWO

### Learning and Teaching

We aim to promote and enhance quality teaching and learning designed to encourage lifelong learning that is both self directed and reflective in nature.

#### Our goals for 2016 are:

- Continued engagement with BCE's Delivering Excellence in Learning and Teaching (DELT) Strategy with particular emphasis on student literacy
- Use Teacher Learning Circles to engage with the LIFE 2.0 Learning Management System and the Visible Learning Framework in order to enhance classroom pedagogy and improve student learning outcomes
- Provide opportunities for Curriculum Middle Leaders to further develop their capacity to support teachers to identify skill needs/deficits in order to enhance teacher pedagogical practices to address them
- Engage with the endorsement and external assessment trials leading towards the implementation of the new system of senior assessment and tertiary entrance
- Outsource elements of VET coordination
- Mapping of pastoral and curriculum programs to ensure consistency of language and themes in relation to personal capabilities

## PRIORITY FOUR

### Strategic Resourcing

- Engage in BCE's Cyclical Review process through both the annual Internal Review of planned Priority Components and the comprehensive five-yearly External Review
