LITERACY

GOAL

Developing students' literacy capacity continues as a focus in 2019. Strategies to grow students' writing proficiency will be enhanced with an emerging focus on reading/reading comprehension.

TARGET

By the end of 2018, students will be in target range as per the following:

Writing Year 7: 70%; Year 8: 80%; Year 9: 80%; Year 10: 85%

NAPLAN Benchmark: 70% of Year 7/9 students in > Band 2+

PAT-R Benchmark: 70% of all students achieving > ES0.2

STUDENT WELLBEING

To develop the pastoral support of students through both enhancing current, and introducing new, programs and processes to ensure optimum wellbeing and engagement for all students.

By the end of 2019, our feedback mechanisms - will demonstrate a very high level of student satisfaction: with being a part of the Siena community (>80% enjoy coming to school), high level of recognition (>90%) and support of the programs and processes that exist to enhance wellbeing and engagement (>80%). Furthermore, the College will achieve an attendance rate of >92% as an indicator of student satisfaction.
