Issuing of Statements

In 2025 Fees and Levies will be charged annually and the Statement issued in early February. Term Statements will be issued at the beginning of each term for Co-curricular Activities and any additional Field Trips/Excursions which were not known at the time of determining the fees. You will be notified of these charges.

Payment Options

- Payment of Fees and Levies can be made annually or by direct debit on a weekly, fortnightly or monthly basis.
- **The preferred method of payment is via FACTS and families wishing to pay fees via instalments are required to sign up for a payment plan via the College website or pay in full via instructions on statement.**
- Full account settlement is required to be completed by the end of Term 4 each year.

Further Information

Families' commitment to meet the payment of College fees is appreciated and essential for our school to provide quality educational outcomes for our students. When committing to additional costs for sports and activities, it is an expectation of the College all fees are up to date when adding these extra charges. Timely communication is important if experiencing difficulty paying fees by the due date.
